How to build a winning fundraising team

You've signed up for the Corporate Challenge, which is great! Now it's time to create your winning team.



Step 1: Recruit Team Members

The first thing to do is to inform your team that you'll be taking part in the Corporate Challenge. Explan what this involves and how important it is to Pendleside Hospice. Use this as an opportunity to find out who might be interested in joining a fundraising team. Once you get commitments from a few people, ask them to rally other people to join in your mission!



Step 2: Assign Roles

Set up an initial meeting to define fundraising roles. It's good to do this from the outset so that expectations are clear. Consider who will take control of planning the events, who will help market your initiatives on social media, and who will take charge of the finances.

Step 3: Plan Your Fundraising

Once you've set up your team, it's time to start generating some fundraising ideas and getting those dates in the diary.

Be sure to set up your JustGiving page as soon as the Corporate Challenge starts too! Share this with your friends, families, clients, suppliers, and more. Pendleside Hospice will provide a designated JustGiving link at the launch event.

Set a fundraising goal, create a timeline, and assign team roles for efficiency.

2. Leverage the £50 Starter Fund

Use it wisely—buy materials, promote events, or kick-start a small fundraiser.

3. Use Your Business Strengths

Incorporate fundraising into your products, services, and business network.

4. Host Engaging Fundraisers

Plan fun activities like bake sales, quizzes, physical challenges, or raffles.

5. Get Social & Spread the Word

Use social media, email, and word-of-mouth to maximize awareness and donations.

6. Involve Customers & Clients

Encourage donations through sales, events, or customer-led fundraising.

7. Secure Match Funding

Ask your company or partners to match donations to double your impact.

8. Collaborate with Other Teams

Team up with other businesses for bigger events and shared success.

9. Keep Motivation High

Celebrate milestones, create friendly competition, and share Pendelside Hospice stories.

10. Finish Strong

Plan a final big push, thank supporters, and share your achievements.
