The Corporate Challenge is a key campaign for the Hospice, and every year, we are amazed by the businesses that step up to take part.

**Pendleside Hospice expects to incur running costs of more than £6.4 million over the next 12 months. Only around 20% of this will be funded through NHS grants, meaning the Hospice must raise over £4.9 million this year through fundraising**
